UPDATED NOTICE (10/9/20)

As with other Shuls around the world, protection against the COVID19 virus is requiring the implementation of changes to our normal routine and Minyonim. Our Shul is no exception. Some of these changes may be difficult but we are trying to work within the CDC and New York State guidelines and ask for your cooperation and understanding as we try to ensure everyone's safety.

<u>Shul</u>

- Anyone who enters into Shul must wear a mask covering both their mouth and nose at all times. No exceptions!
- If you find it difficult to keep your face covered, please step outside
- Social distancing is required. To accomplish this, please only sit in a seat with a blue tape.
- Although home care aides may accompany a person to and from their seats, they should not remain in Shul for davening.

Shemini Atzeres

- Tables cannot be reserved in the non-catered Sukka.. Tables should be used on a first come, first serve basis. If others are waiting, please hurry your meal.
- Please do not call or e-mail about seating in the catered Sukka. Every effort is being made to provide social distancing. If on the chance the seating does not meet your distancing requirements, a second shift will be available.
- When in the Sukkah, please wear a mask when walking around and respect everyone's comfort level when it comes to social distancing.

Simchas Torah

- Many Shuls are eliminating or limiting hakafos and related activities. To provide a safe environment while still preserving some measure of the Yom Tov spirit, the Board has decided on the following:
 - <u>Candy</u>. No individual candy distribution. Instead, the Kehilla is distributing special packages for the children, both night and day. To help sponsor these packages, please click here: <u>https://www.kajinc.org/form/simchas-torah-candies.html</u>. Any amount is welcome. A list of donors will be included in the next newsletter.
 - Children should line up in the playground maintaining a 6-foot distance between families at the beginning of the 3rd hakafa for the candy distribution. Barring extenuating cirumstances, such as children in quarantine, packages will only be given to children present for the distribution.
 - Hakofos-Dancing. Hakofos will be limited: A limited number of Sifrei Torah will be taken around Shul. Other than this, only dancing in place, at your seat.
 - Kol HaNe'orim. Boys should not come to the Bima for the Kol HaNe'orim aliyo. Names that are submitted in advance, click here: <u>https://www.kajinc.org/form/Kol%20HaNe'orim%20Names</u> will be read in the mi sheberach after the Kol HaNe'orim aliyo. Please only list names of boys whom you anticipate will be in shul for the aliyo. Please submit a separate form for each boy.
