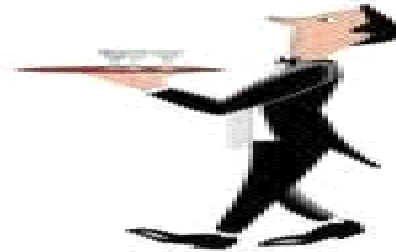

If you wish to have your matzo shipped by UPS, please indicate so in the appropriate space on the order form. If you order online, the online system will compute the shipping costs. All shipped orders must be prepaid by cash, check or credit card when ordered. Shipping charges can be estimated as follows:

If you are unable to pick up on those dates, please select shipping when placing your order, as we cannot accommodate pickups on other dates. When it gets closer to those dates, we will publicize if the pickups will be with or without appointment.
