Halacha for Erev Yom Kippur: *If you are driving to shul for Kol Nidre, DO NOT recite shehechyanu when lighting candles. Instead, light the candles at home with the appropriate bracha of Lehadlik ner shel Yom Hakipurim. Have in mind while reciting the bracha that you intend to drive to shul. You are not yet accepting Yom Tov and therefore the bracha of shehechyanu cannot be recited. The appropriate time to say shehechyanu is in shul after Kol Nidrei.*
