PARASHA OUTLINE BY CANTOR VOGEL

God continues to give Moshe instructions for building the Mishkan-Tabernacle.

1. The collection of the half-shekel for census taking and maintenance of the Temple.
2. Instructions for fashioning the Kiyor-laver, the incense spices, and the oil for anointing the vessels of the Mishkan and the priests.
3. God designates Bezalel and Oholiav as the master craftsmen to build the Mishkan.
4. A special reminder to keep Shabbat-even when building the Mishkan.
5. The sin of the Golden Calf, Moshe breaks the luchot-tablets of the laws, and the punishment of the sinners.
6. Limitations on contacts with non-Jewish people.
7. Moshe ascends Mt. Sinai for two additional 40 day periods to ask God to forgive the people for the sin of the Golden Calf.
8. Moshe receives a second set of luchot, learns God's 13 attributes of mercy.
9. When Moshe returns to the camp his face takes on a divine glow.

Haftarah Note

Today's haftarah tells about an incident during the life of Eliyahu Hanavi. In his time the people Israel were worshipping Ba'al an idol. Eliyahu confronts them, challenges them to choose between the true God and the false one, and proves that there is only one true God. The similarities to the incident of the golden calf in today's parsha are unmistakable from the sanctification of God's name to the parallel prayers of Moshe and Eliyahu.

AIPAC Israel Update

Bipartisan Senate Resolution Urges UN to Renew Iran Arms Embargo

A bipartisan Senate resolution urges the United Nations to renew sanctions on Iran that are set to expire in October. Sens. Pat Toomey (R-PA) and Jacky Rosen (D-NV) authored the resolution calling on the U.N. Security Council to extend the U.N. arms embargo and ballistic missile restrictions on Iran. The world's leading state sponsor of terrorism is on the brink of being able to import and export advanced weapons under international law. While benefiting U.S. adversaries, ending the embargo would make an already chaotic Middle East even more dangerous for America and Israel. The United States must ensure that Iran is not given the green light to stockpile advanced weapons and accelerate its weapons proliferation to terrorist proxies across the Middle East. Urge your members of Congress to extend the U.N. arms embargo on Iran.
