## PARSHA OUTLINE BY CANTOR VOGEL

1. Laws applying to Kohanim in general and to the Kohen Hagadol-the High Priest in particular: Mourning practices, permissible marriages, wounds that disqualify a Kohen from serving in the Temple service temporarily or permanently.
2. The wounds or imperfections that render an animal unfit to be used as a korban.
3. A description of the holy days in the calendar: Shabbat, Pesach, the Omer period, Shavuot, Rosh Hashanah, Yom Kippur and Sukkot.
4. Laws regarding the menorah and the showbread in the Temple.
5. The incident of the man who cursed God. (Recall Moshe killing the Egyptian, this was the child born of the illicit relationship between that Egyptian and a Jewish woman).

### Haftorah Note

The navi Yechezkel echoes Moshe in today's parsha. Moshe laid out the laws and guidelines that would govern the lives of the Kohanim from his time forward. Yechezkel lays out the laws and guidelines that will govern the lives of the Kohanim who will serve in the Third Temple, which we hope will be built speedily, in our time, and for which the Machon Hamikdash the Temple Institute in Yerushalayim is even now actively preparing.

#### Eurovision 2019 Kicks Off in Plenty of Style in Israel

For everyone out there wondering what the fuss about the Eurovision Song Contest is all about, Sunday evening's opening ceremony certainly provided a glamorous response. Hopeful contestants from the 41 participating countries walked down the orange carpet at Tel Aviv's Habima Square in full battle dress, ready for the big win, and the show was spectacular. According to ISRAEL21c, the main attraction for Israelis was of course last year's champion, Netta Barzilai, whose win brought the 64th edition of the international singing competition to Israel this spring. Clad in an all-white outfit and carried by three assistants, she made an unforgettable entrance. This year's contestants also upped the style game, as seen in the memorable outfits of Hatari of Iceland, John Lundvik from Sweden and Bilal Hassani of France. The show's Israeli presenters Bar Refaeli, Erez Tal, Assi Azar and Lucy Ayoub also graced the orange carpet. Two rounds of semi-finals – on Tuesday and Thursday evening – will see the contestants trying to reach the grand finale on Saturday night, during which the representatives of 26 countries will try to win the coveted title by popular vote.
