## PARASHA OUTLINE BY CANTOR VOGEL

1. Korach, Moshe's cousin foments a rebellion against Moshe and Aharon, aided by Datan and Aviram, challenging the legitimacy of Moshe and Aharon's authority.
2. 250 Levi'im side with Korach, and are told to prepare themselves to offer ketoret-incense.
3. Korach and his immediate family and main supporters are punished by God as the earth opens up and swallows them. The 250 Levi'im are burned.
4. The incense pans used by the rebels are melted and attached to the mizbeach-altar as a warning to future rebels.
5. The nation continues to murmur against Moshe and Aharon. All the princes of the tribes are commanded to leave their staffs in the Mishkan overnight. God causes Aharon's staff to bloom and bear fruit as a sign of God's divine choice.
6. The gifts the Israelites are required to give the Kohanim and Leviim as a "salary" for their service in the Temple, to the exclusion of having a regular job and income.

### Haftorah Note

In today's parsha an exasperated Moshe turns to God and says: I have not taken anything from them nor have I wronged them in any way. Shmuel Hanavi in the Haftorah employs similar language to the nation when they ask for a king, which Shmuel understands to be repudiation of himself. Also, the Haftorah speaks of "renewing" the coronation of Shaul Hamelech. Similarly, in today's parsha God's choice of leaders, Moshe and Aharon is "renewed" or reconfirmed.
