PARASHA OUTLINE BY CANTOR VOGEL

1. The eternal brit-covenant with God, a warning against abrogating it and the tragic consequences of violating the brit.
2. The concept of teshuva-repentance after sin and punishment.
3. God's promise to accept teshuva, act with mercy, and gather the scattered nation.
4. The ability to understand the Torah is not beyond the reach or obligation of anyone.
5. We have been given a choice between good/life and bad/death, and advice: choose life.
6. The events of the last day of Moshe's life: he encouraged the nation to conquer the land of Canaan, he publicly transferred the leadership to his successor Yehoshua, and commanded the mitzva of hakhel-gathering the nation at the conclusion of the Shemittah-sabbatical year in Jerusalem on Sukkot.
7. Moshe writes a copy of the Torah and gives it to the Levi'im to keep in the Aron Kodesh.
8. Moshe teaches the nation the poem Ha'azinu.

Haftarah Note

Today's haftarah is the seventh and last of the Haftarot of Consolation. In this haftarah, Zion accepts the consolations directly from God. The prophet tells that in the days to come the world will know that Israel has not been forgotten. The walls of Jerusalem will be rebuilt and God will again as He did in the desert perform miracles for His nation.

AIPAC Israel Update

Palestinians Fail to get Arab League to Condemn Israel-UAE Deal

On Wednesday, the Palestinian Authority failed to get the Arab League's foreign ministers to endorse a resolution criticizing the U.S.-brokered normalization deal between Israel and the United Arab Emirates. The UAE joined Egypt and Jordan in paving the path to peace through recognition and engagement rather than seeking to isolate and boycott the Jewish state. Peace and reconciliation are possible when American support for Israel is strong and our ally is secure. The Palestinian leadership should end its boycott of Israel and America and return to the negotiating table. To advance the pursuit of peace, America should bolster Israel's security and the U.S.-Israel partnership, as hundreds of members of Congress continue to support on a bipartisan basis.
