15 MINUTES AFTER KIDDUSH: **Esty Shushan** is a social activist and Haredi-Orthodox filmmaker. She is a leader in the protest campaign, "No Voice, No Vote" which calls for representation of Orthodox women in the Knesset and for the rights of Orthodox women, bringing their silent voices to the center of Israeli discourse. Her short film *Barren*, which was screened in the *Short Film Corner* at the Cannes Film Festival and the UK Jewish Film Festival in 2015, is part of the extensive activities to encourage inside-Orthodox dialogue on issues of women's rights, preventing extremist and revealing muted Orthodox voices. In 2015, Esty was selected to give a lecture at TedX Jerusalem, where she shared her activities in the field.
