Ruth Berger

Community Builder Award

Ruth has been a member of Beth Sholom for over twenty years and cannot say enough about how blessed she is to be part of what feels like an extended family. For the past five years she has taught a fun class at Beth Sholom, designed to explore the meaning and magic of the Siddur, Chumash, and Tanach through familiarity with the workings of the Hebrew language. In consultation with Rabbi Antine and Maharat Fruchter, she is excited to be teaching a new

adult Hebrew Literacy Class for beginners as well as for those who would simply like to brush up on their Hebrew reading skills. Together with Gayle Nadler, Ruth was responsible recently for compiling a booklet of Additional Blessings and Prayers that are printed in Hebrew, English, and a transliterated Hebrew so as to make them accessible to as many congregants as possible. Ruth is a certified clinical therapist and works at the Jewish Social Service Agency. However, she considers her most valuable contribution to our Jewish community to be her daughter and son-in-law, Jocelyn and Danny Krifcher, and their four extraordinary children — Alon, Galit, Yael, and Avital.



#### Jocelyn Krifcher

Community Builder Award

Jocelyn is a seasoned community volunteer and activist. Nationally, she is on the boards of the Jewish Federations of North America, Israel Action Network, Prizmah Center for Jewish Day Schools, and AIPAC's National Council. In Washington, Jocelyn has held many leadership positions at the Federation, including Secretary, VP for Women's Philanthropy and for Israel and Overseas, and chair of the Endowment Fund's Grants Committee. She is on the

Federation's Board of Directors, Campaign Cabinet, and is a trustee of the Endowment Fund. She is on AIPAC's Washington Council, and serves on the Boards of the Charles E. Smith Jewish Day School and Sunflower Café. She is also a co-founder of Operation Embrace and a Wexner Heritage Fellow. Jocelyn has received numerous awards in recognition of her service to the community, including the Jack Kay Campaigner of the Year award from the Jewish Federation of Greater Washington, and the Community Leadership Award from the Jewish Community Relations Council. She holds a Bachelor's degree from Hebrew University, Jerusalem and a Master's degree from Brandeis University. Jocelyn and her husband Danny have been members of Beth Sholom since 1994 and are the proud parents of Alon, Galit, Yael, and Avital.





Bashi Packer Community Builder Award

Bashi moved to Potomac from Philadelphia in 1990. She and Roger have been loyal members of Beth Sholom for 26 years. In her early years at the shul, Bashi was on the board, and introduced birthday kiddushes, old member/new member parties, and Purim Shpiels to the shul. A child of Holocaust survivors, Bashi is a volunteer at the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum, where she does research on victim histories. She also volunteers for Operation Embrace, ASIRT,

Sunflower Bakery, Beth Sholom ECC, Bikur Cholim, and the Chevra Kadisha. In her past life, as a biomedical engineer, she worked in pharmaceutical RandD, and in bioinformatics at the NCI. She is a devoted wife to Roger, a proud mother to Zavi and Mike, a doting Bubby to Annie, David, and Ayelet, and a lifelong Cubs fan. Bashi greatly appreciates the openness and supportive nature of Beth Sholom and our community.



Jonathan Engler Member of the Year

Jonathan has been a member of the Beth Sholom Board of Directors, and Chair of the Youth Committee, for the past three years. In partnership with the professional leadership and his colleagues on the Board and Youth Committee, Jonathan has been very involved in efforts to develop sustainable and inclusive youth programming at Beth Sholom for young people of all backgrounds. Teen Leadership Award

Jacob is a senior at Churchill High School. He is a weekly layner and shallach tzibur in the teen minyan and serves as gabbai for Shabbat mincha. This past year, Jacob tutored many bar mitzvah boys. He also created and led a tutor training session for teens interested in becoming b'nai mitzvah tutors. As a freshman and newcomer to the public school system, Jacob founded the Jewish Student Union. It has since become one of Churchill's largest and most

vibrant clubs, attracting approximately 100 students to each meeting. Jacob will always consider Beth Sholom his home and is grateful to have grown up in such a warm and special community.

This Shabbat is so exciting to us because it is all about community! This Shabbat is about five individuals who have stepped up throughout the years to make our community the strong, loving, and vibrant place that we all care for so deeply. It is also about the rest of us recognizing and honoring them for their leadership.

Here are some ways that we, from the clergy perspective, are particularly grateful to our honorees, in addition to all of the other things that they do for Beth Sholom and the broader community.

**Ruth** — We have so many in our shul whose lack of Hebrew knowledge makes it difficult for them to connect to our tefilah which is such an important part of what we do. Your Hebrew classes for congregants and converts are so vitally important in their lives. You don't only teach Hebrew--you teach people how to live meaningful Jewish lives through our holy language.

**Jocelyn** — We are trying to find a board of a community organization, that we believe in that you have not been on! You are a model of community service. You teach all of us that if you are passionate about an issue, it is not enough to talk. We have to act. Your deep love for Israel and the Jewish community shines through so much of your service and is a source of inspiration to all of us.

**Bashi** — You are a volunteer extraordinaire! You can always be counted on when people are in need. We are particularly touched by the way you support friends and community members during the shiva week and beyond. Your love and friendship goes beyond your inner circle as you are always one of the first to invite new members and make them part of your ever expanding network of friends and people that you care about.

**Jonathan** — Four years ago, for the first time in decades, our shul found itself with only one full time rabbi. We were particularly concerned that Youth Services would fall through the cracks. You made sure that this did not happen. You were a constant presence in the office. You offered guidance, developed programs and so much

more. You had the vision of bringing in a shlicha from Israel and you even travelled to Israel to meet with our wonderful shlicha Rena to ensure that the program happened! We are so indebted to you.

Jacob — Sometimes we have to remind ourselves that you are still in High School! You lein, lead davening and serve as Shabbat afternoon Gabbai. You were instrumental in creating our new teen-led B'nai Mitzvah tutoring program. You model to all of us what is means to deepen your Judaism while you are primarily in a secular school environment. So many of our younger kids love to lein and daven and have joined teen minyan because of you.

We also have so much gratitude for those who have worked so hard to ensure the success of our 70th Annual Honoree Celebration: Our Event Chairs, **Evelyn Marcus-Wheeler**, **Toni Waldman** and **Arnie Hiller**, have been amazing and have given so much of their time because they love our community so much.






