

Leviticus 19:9-11, 32-37

9: When you reap the harvest of your land, you shall not reap all the way to the edges of your field, or gather the gleanings of your harvest.

10: You shall not pick your vineyard bare, or gather the fallen fruit of your vineyard; you shall leave them for the poor and the stranger: I Adonai am your God.

11: You shall not steal; you shall not deal deceitfully or falsely with one another.

32: You shall rise before the aged and show deference to the old; you shall fear your God: I am Adonai.

33: When a stranger resides with you in your land, you shall not wrong him.

34: The stranger who resides with you shall be to you as one of your citizens; you shall love him as yourself, for you were strangers in the land of Egypt: I Adonai am your God.

35: You shall not falsify measures of length, weight, or capacity.

36: You shall have an honest balance, honest weights, an honest ephah, and an honest hin.

37: You shall faithfully observe all My laws and all My rules: I am Adonai.
