Transition to Two's

Our unique curriculum is specifically designed to provide young children who are turning 2 years old between October 1st and February 29th with a developmentally appropriate environment to play, explore, discover, and engage in a nurturing, supportive and interactive setting. Separation from a parent or caregiver is successfully achieved as the children transition to a modified Playschool 2's program.

In the fall, children and their parent/ caregiver meet twice a week with a Teacher and Assistant Teacher for an interactive program involving socialization, creative learning, art, music and movement, fine and gross motor play and an introduction to Hebrew and Spanish through music. In January, children are encouraged to separate from their parent/caregiver and phase into a longer school day. Class time slowly increases to two hours and the children learn to master their environment independently.

For some children this may be the first time they are going into a classroom setting. Children explore the classroom environment through play and social interaction. The curriculum is a modified Playschool 2's program. The children also have opportunities to learn about other children's feelings, and to discover the Yes, it is very early, but it is amazing what they can learn from one another, including language acquisition, and even motor development.
