

# 2023-24 Budget Highlights

- A \$75 (3.2 %) increase in Annual Committment is necessary to compensate with the rising costs of expenses
- The Endowment alone provides 19% of Operating Funds
- Annual Committment provides only about 50% of CBE's Operating Funds
- Over 33% of Operating Funds are provided by Annual Underwriting Gifts, supported by 119 congregant families who donate above Annual Committment, other donations and CBE's Endowment (see names on reverse side)
