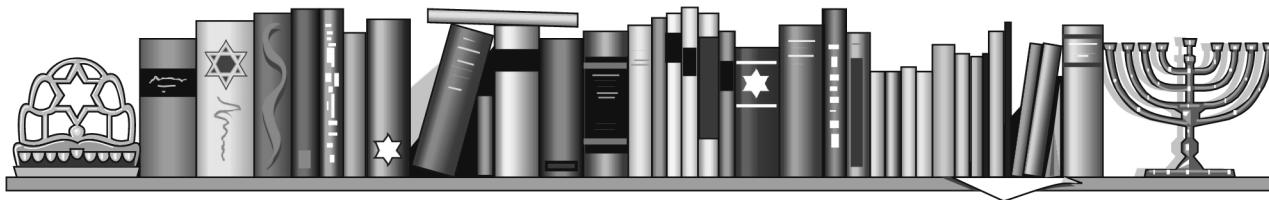

- Develop personal statements.
- Write a Confirmation Essay.
- Participate in the Confirmation service.
- Learn to appreciate the power of giving Tzedakah.
