



CHILDREN'S PROGRAMMING

At 9:30am on both Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur during Morning Service 1:

- Children 1-4 years of age will play in our Kids Kehillah room supervised by Kids Kehillah staff.
- Children in Pre-K through 2nd grade will do crafts, read stories and have play time with our JEEP teachers while parents are in the sanctuary.
- Children in 3rd through 6th grade will explore the Holy Days through trivia, games, and experiential learning activities with our JEEP teachers and GORFTY youth leaders.

Space is limited for the children's programming, so it is important to sign your child(ren) up when making your High Holy Days reservations. Masks will be required for all staff and children age 2 and above.

OUTDOOR FAMILY SERVICE

Dress casually and bring your lawn chairs for a family-friendly, musical outdoor service led by Rabbi Engel, Cantor Bryce, and our children's and teen choirs. The service will be about one hour.

PARKING FOR THE HIGH HOLY DAYS

We will not have off-site parking or shuttle busses this year, so please utilize the street parking around CRJ. We appreciate your cooperation and respect for our neighbors by avoiding lawns and driveways when parking on neighborhood streets. Please take note of "No Parking" signs around the neighborhood to avoid ticketing. Our security staff will allow those with an official State of Florida disability placard to park on campus, if space is available. RESERVATIONS AND SEATING

Reservations for seating will be made available to CRJ members in good standing. The reservations for in-person services will only reserve space in the sanctuary. They will not reserve specific seats. These reservations allow CRJ to safely plan for those attending in-person services during the High Holy Days. Invitations will only be mailed to individuals who have made reservations for in-person seating. If you plan to join us virtually, you must make a reservation so we can send you the Zoom links.

SECURITY

For the safety and security of our community, the invitation will be mailed to your home and will be required to enter the building. Tallit bags, purses, and other bags will be checked by security personnel. We will have kippot and limited tallitot available, for single use.

BOOK OF REMEMBRANCE

It is a beautifully written, inspiring, and contemporary High Holy Days Prayer Book, *Mishkan HaNefesh* (Tabernacle of the Soul). It is a two-volume set, one for Rosh Hashanah and one for Yom Kippur.
