# BINE Informational Bulletin

The Broward Information Network Exchange (BINE) would like to share the following information to assist in Florida's local business operations.

## Stores with dedicated shopping hours for elderly

**Dollar General:** Dedicated first hour each day for seniors.

**Target:** Target will dedicate the first hour of shopping each Wednesday for "vulnerable guests, including the elderly and those with underlying health concerns."

**Whole Foods:** All Whole Foods Market stores in the U.S. and Canada will service customers who are 60 and older one hour before opening to the public.

**Sedano's:** Sedano's Supermarkets to dedicate an hour from 7:00 AM to 8:00 AM to serve seniors and more vulnerable customers.

**Trader Joe's:** Until further notice, all Trader Joe's stores will be open from 9:00 AM until 7:00 PM.

**Fresh Market:** Reserved shopping hour for seniors and those most at risk between 8:00 AM and 9:00 AM.

**Walmart:** Walmart throughout the 50 states will be restricting their hours to the public beginning tonight, March 19, 2020. Going forward they will be closing all facilities to the public beginning at 8:30 PM and reopening each morning at 7:30 AM. They will be using this time to clean and restock the Store for their customers.

Walmart will also be offering specific times for Seniors only to shop. Starting Tuesday, March 24, 2020, and every Tuesday until April 28, 2020, stores will open one hour early (**6:00 AM**) for the seniors (60+). Walmart's Pharmacy and Vision Centers will also be open and staffed at this time to address any of their needs.

Walmart will continue to limit purchase quantities to one per person on specific types of merchandise to allow as many customers as possible to get their needed supply items. This is being reinforced with new signing and in some cases, Walmart may create queue lines for these items if crowds form with social distancing in mind.
