One message that sticks out to me is the following... He says that in the future, the Jews might make mistakes and turn away from G-d, but there's always a chance to make things right and come back.

As a now-famous Navy Seal Commander from YouTube once said, "make your bed in the morning," resulting in you feeling a sense of accomplishment to kick off your day. One good action leads to another good action, and so forth.
