

## **High Holiday Auction Dinner FAQs**

Q. What exactly is the goal of this dinner?

A. The goal is to provide a comfortable forum with great food for community members to come together and purchase and bid on High Holiday honors, as well as take advantage of sponsorships.

Q. I don't think I can afford to be a major player in the live bidding, should I still come?

A. Yes, you can still purchase many honors at fixed prices, as well as by joining others in forming "teams" to bid on honors for someone in particular, as well as by joining consortiums. Keep in mind that you have time to pay off your pledge, so you may be able to afford more over a period of time than you realize.

Q. How long to I have to pay off my pledge?

A. While we prefer that members pay off their pledges as soon as possible, they may pay it off over the the course of a year.

Q. Can I participate by using ma'aser money?

A. Yes, this money counts for ma'aser contributions.

Q. Is my donation tax-deductible?

A, Yes, your contribution is 100% tax deductible.

Q. What are some of the consortiums I can join?

A. Wine for Kiddush and Havdala is one, and coordinated by Rabbi Dave Silverman. Another is Ner La'maor, to help offset the electricity costs. A third is "Adon Olam" in honor of Mrs. Miriam Feldman, which is coordinated by Janie Feldman.

Q. For the honors sales, which minyanim honors are for sale?

A. Honors at the Main Minyan as well as the 9am Minyan will be available for purchase.

Q: I prefer to reserve my donation for the Kol Nidreh appeal. Shouldn't I just wait until then?

A. This year we will be expanding the Kol Nidreh appeal, with opportunities to contribute at various venues, including at the Auction dinner, if you would like.
