Beth Jacob Atlanta Minyan Protocols – Late October 2020

***Anyone visiting from out-of-town or returning from travel out-of-town should contact one of our rabbis before attending minyanim.** Note that hosting out-of-town guests is generally discouraged at this time of heightened precaution, and those who do so must similarly be cleared by the Rabbis before attending services.

*Anyone who is experiencing any symptoms of illness, or who had known exposure to COVID in the last ten days, may not come onto the Shul campus.

*Participants must wear a **face mask covering one's nose and mouth** at all times.

*Our seats which have been carefully measured and spaced. Please do not move them without permission. Please daven near your seat.

*Weekday Mincha / Maariv is hosted in both the Main Shul and Heritage Hall. Please attend the Heritage Hall minyan if there are no open seats in the Main Shul, or if you prefer a smaller crowd.

*The bathrooms near the Main Shul and near Heritage Hall are open for limited use. Only one person may enter at a time.

*Bring Siddurim and Chumashim from home.

*An *aliyah* recipient should return to his seat right after his *aliyah*. We encourage use of sanitizer before and after the *Aliyah*.
