

#### Flag Day Celebration - Sat., June 14



Everyone is invited to celebrate Flag Day with us!

When: Saturday, June 14, 2014 following kiddush (~1pm)
Where: Star Spangled Banner Flag House, corner of Albemarle & Pratt Streets
What: The historic Flag House, museum, gardens and grounds will be open to
the public for free.

The flag that inspired the writing of the Star Spangled Banner was made at this location two hundred years ago. Flag Day commemorates the adoption of the United States flag in 1777.

As early as 1917, B'nai Israel held a special flag raising ceremony at our synagogue.
