

Ma'aravi/Polak is a folk duo that performs an eclectic mix of music from many places and periods. Their primary focus is on Jewish folk music from the Judeo-Spanish (Ladino) tradition. They are also keenly interested in the music of the Breslov Hasidim, to which they add their unique interpretations. Ma'aravi/Polak consists of Rabbi Shuviel Ma'aravi and Joshua Polak.

Rabbi Ma'aravi is actively developing the Baltimore Esnoga, an organization dedicated to building open, inclusive and healing communities infused with the light and inspiration of the Western Sephardic tradition. He has developed a course on Jewish Meditational Music, presented this summer at Common Ground on the Hill in Westminster, MD.

Joshua Polak is the owner/proprieter of Guitars of Pikesville. Guitars of Pikesville sells and repairs guitars and other stringed instruments, carries a uniquely broad collection of music books, and offers guitar lessons to players of all ages and levels of experience. More that this, Guitars of Pikesville has become the nucleus of a diverse community of musicians who have become deeply connected and supportive to one another.
