



We are thrilled to announce that the DAT Minyan received a grant from the Orthodox Union as part of its recent initiative to award grants totaling \$100,000 to 35 organizations to enhance and invigorate the return to shul as more people are vaccinated against the COVID-19 virus. The DAT Minyan is the only shul in Colorado to receive this grant.

The OU received over 300 submissions across 34 states, from a range of synagogues large and small. The 35 winners chosen by the OU Grant Committee represented both out-of-the-box thinking and opportunities that are more likely to rebuild and reaffirm the value of synagogue and community for their congregants.

The DAT Minyan's grant is designated for women's programming and will be used to develop and enhance our long-running and popular SHAWL (Shabbat Afternoon Women's Learning) series. Stay tuned for exciting updates!
