

Guide to Davening In Shul on Rosh Hashanah 5781

Welcome! We are so glad that you are joining us for Rosh Hashanah morning services. Below is some information that will help you navigate and follow our davening this year, as there are a number of changes from our normal Rosh Hashanah minyan experience.

Please remain in your seat, do not move any seats, and do not sit in any folding chair near your seat (use it for your tallis bag or glasses etc.)

We will be omitting many piyutim. Please see inside for a list of what we will be reciting, along with page numbers.

We will not be announcing page numbers as frequently as usual. Please follow along using this guide. If you need assistance please look in a friend's machzor or get their attention (without talking) and they will be glad to show you the place.

The Chazzan will lead any and all singing during davening. We ask that if you want to engage in congregational singing with the Chazzan you do so by humming along or singing in an undertone.

This year, the Rabbi or the Gabbai will open the Ark whenever necessary.

Birkat Kohanim: Kohanim will wash their own hands. Leviim, please remain in your seats. Kohanim should be mindful of social distancing.
