Wow – that was amazing!

Last week we were honored to host "Rabbi G" for an exciting scholar-in-residence weekend that had him speaking 6 different times and bringing out over 300 people to hear his inspirational messages. His mantra of "Power" (connecting to the divine), "Peace" (being in touch with the power from within) and "Purpose" (understanding that we are all alive in order to achieve a purpose, which often means teaching the world by the way we live our lives and face our challenges) left people with an entirely new way to view and face challenges in life, and understand that everything is from Hashem for purpose! We look forward to creating more opportunities like this in the future, and always welcome individuals to come forward to help sponsor such events so that our community can learn and grow together!

As we turn our attention to Pesach and people are busy cleaning their houses or arranging their travel plans to be with family elsewhere, it is a great time to remind ourselves to pause and not get caught up in the logistical preparations and lose sight of the purpose and message of the holiday.

Simply put, Pesach is a holiday of transmitting the story of our people and how that emanates from our belief in and relationship with Hashem. This story is not a fable in a book, but a first-hand witness account that has been handed down from generation to generation. It is our responsibility to both deepen our understanding of that story and its implications on our Jewish destiny, as well as to reinforce that message to the people that most look up to us for guidance- our children. As the Torah tells us: "V'Higadeta L'bincha"- and you shall tell it to your children.

This week's parsha, Metzora, reminds us that the way we speak and what we speak about make a difference, both to ourselves and to our relationships with others. As we approach Pesach, let's put thought into what we want to say at our Seders and how we want to best give over the fundamental lessons of our faith to our families.

In the week ahead, make sure to put some time aside to research, prepare, and yes, even google ideas that can strengthen your appreciation of this awesome task, and share ideas that can do the same for those around your table.
