Dear Members & Guests,

As we just entered the month of Adar (Rishon) a few days ago, there are two primary characteristics of the month that come to mind.

The first is that of simcha (happiness), as the Talmud teaches "M'shenichnas Adar Marbin B'simcha" (As Adar enters, we increase our joy). This year, being a Jewish leap year, we are blessed with two Adars, so there are plenty of days of joy to go around. However, perhaps it pays to first pause and remind ourselves that joy is not a destination, as much as it is a process and a mind frame, as they say: "the city of happiness is in your state of mind" (guess that joke works better in the US).

The second aspect that Adar reminds us of, as does this week's parsha of Terumah, is the value of giving. Our Torah portion this week speaks about the importance of giving, and giving with passion, rather than resentment. Purim, which is on its way, is a chag in which there are multiple mitzvot that reinforce our need to give. And so we are reminded that we exist not only for ourselves, but for others as well.

Perhaps both of these characteristics are actually more connected than we think.

People often think they feel good when they get something, but as we mature, we realize that giving actually enables us to feel a much more meaningful and deep feeling of joy
