Dear Members & Guests,

Special Reminder: This Shabbat we read Parshat Zachor – the only Torah reading all year that is actually a biblical mitzvah for all women and men to hear, so please try your best to make it to shul by the end of the Torah reading (approx. 10:20). There will be a second reading after davening for those who missed it.

We live in unpredictable times. There is instability throughout the Middle East; a growing number of anti-Semitic and anti-Israel sentiments are spreading throughout the United States and Europe; North American university campuses have become rife with those supporting the Palestinian cause and decrying Israel.

However, I do not mention this in order to put a damper on the celebrations of a very joyous time of year, but rather to encourage us to understand and embody the reason for the joy that we are to experience as a result of Purim.

On Purim, we revel in the security of knowing that we have only to turn to Hashem and we will have the ability to overcome obstacles and enemies regardless of how the situation might look. The Purim story is one in which the Jews faced a genocidal plot to eradicate them completely, only to have the entire situation reverse as soon as the Jews gathered together and directed their prayers and their hopes towards Hashem. When the Jews of Persia recognized and trusted in Hashem, He showed them (and us) that He is always there for us; we just have to trust.

This Purim, let's work on our trust in Hashem and strengthen our connection with Him, so that He may strengthen our people now just as He did for the Jews in Persia!

Looking forward to seeing you all on Purim!
