Rabbi's Message

You Tube WEB DVAR with Rabbi Zwickler—CHECK IT OUT!

Moshe Rabbeinu changed the name of Hoshea to Yehoshua before the latter departed with the other spies. We may wonder why did Moshe change Yehoshua's name exclusively, and not for example Kalev's name as well. Rashi explains that Moshe did this so that Hashem, represented by the letter yud at the beginning of Yehoshua's name, would help him withstand the pressure of the negative spies. Rav Yosef Chaver zt"l offers an additional possibility. He notes that Yehoshua was from shevet Ephraim who was the son of Yosef. Moshe was concerned that perhaps there was something embedded in the DNA that may have been passed down through the generations to Yehoshua. In the beginning of Parshas Vayeshev, the Torah tells us that Yosef brought negative reports about his brothers to his father Yaakov. Although Yosef repented and atoned for this behavior, there was a small possibility that some of the negativity that Yosef was involved with as a young man became supplanted in his home and in his prodigy. It was for this concern that Moshe davened. We can never take the impact of one's environment for granted. Good Shabbos!

Similarly, it is proper to inform a parent that someone may be having a negative influence on his or her child. All preconditions must, of course, be fulfilled – including verification of fact constructive intent.
