Rabbi's Message

You Tube WEB DVAR with Rabbi Zwickler—CHECK IT OUT!

The Torah relates a scenario where the nation may see the vast nations inhabiting the land of Israel and doubt their ability to vanquish their enemies due to their size. Moshe tells the people not to fear such a situation, but to instead remember that which Hashem did to Paroh and Mitzrayim. The Sforno explains that the lesson was for the people to realize that their potential accomplishment would be impossible without Hashem's assistance. This is a lesson that we can apply on a personal level as well. There are moments when we are faced with challenges that may seem insurmountable, yet we are left with no real choice other than meeting the challenge head on. In such circumstances it is helpful to have faith that Hashem is the one who has placed the challenge before us, and believes in our ability to succeed in overcoming it.
