Rabbi's Message

You Tube WEB DVAR with Rabbi Zwickler—CHECK IT OUT!

How often have we heard the words "I am having a senior moment" from someone, when they forget an event or a name. Forgetfulness is almost always seen in a negative context. Rav Nachman MiBreslov zt"l explains that in his eyes, forgetfulness is a great virtue. If we are constantly conscious of the past when it comes to our connection with Hashem, we may never be able to truly strive for growth, because we are frequently reminded of our past misdeeds. The same is true when it comes to our interpersonal experiences.

Rivka tells Yaakov that he will know when Eisav's anger recedes based on how he himself feels about the relationship. Too often we become paralyzed by our past experiences with a given individual, that we miss out on the opportunity to revisit and re-engage in a different, healthier way, out of fear of the past. In such circumstances forgetfulness may be truly virtuous.

Lashon Corner

When someone purchases a new item, one must be careful not to unnecessarily rob him of the joy of his new purchase. Unless there is a constructive purpose in criticizing the purchase, one should find something about it to praise (*Kesubos 17a*). *The more expensive the item, the more careful one must be not to comment negatively.* Even if the item does not meet one's own standards or quality or value, it is likely that the person who made the purchase is satisfied on those counts. Otherwise, he would not have made the purchase. If one cannot find something to praise, he can at least acknowledge that the item is bringing the other person satisfaction: "It must feel great to walk into the living room and see a new couch."
