As we try to turn over a new leaf during these days of Aseres Yemai Teshuva, we sometimes question the sincerity and authenticity of our own commitments. The Chazon Ish was questioned about the commitments people make on Yom Kippur, considering that many have a hard time being faithful to these new undertakings. The Chazon Ish responded that Hashem appreciates a person's effort at strengthening themselves even for a moment. This is an important message for us to internalize as we approach the holiest day of the year. As long as we are truly sincere, the teshuva process can be successful. May this Yom Kippur be truly inspirational on a very personal level for all of us.

- This coming January 1st, close to 100,000 Jews will gather at MetLife Stadium for the celebration of the Siyum Hashas of the Daf Yomi. This event culminates seven years of daily study of the Talmud, with its completion. We wish Mazel Tov to our members who are completing this incredible cycle of Torah learning. The gathering represents a celebration of the love of Torah and a considerable amount of attendees come just to be part of the celebration. The ability to daven, sing, and dance together, with 100,000 Jews is most memorable and inspiring. The shul has purchased more than 100 tickets which are being sold for \$60 in the men's section and \$36 in the women's section, through the shul office. Tickets must be purchased and paid in full, and are available on a first come first serve basis. I would like to thank our sponsor who has subsidized our seats significantly.
