RABBI'S MESSAGE

As we welcome Shabbos, the day of rest, the words in Parshas Bechukosai א ונתתי שלום בארץ - "and I will bring peace upon the land" ring in our ears. May Hashem continue to protect our brethren in Israel, and may they have a peaceful Shabbos. We will be adding a perek of Tehillim in all of our minyanim until further notice.

In the beginning of Parshas Bechukosai Hashem tells the Jewish people that He will bless us if we observe the mitzvos. One of the brachos mentioned is that we will eat the bread of the land and be satiated when doing so. Rashi explains that this means that one will become full from just a small amount of food. The Tzemach Tzedek zt"l suggests that every time that we eat we have the ability to elevate the mundane and experience holiness. He notes that the word maachal(food), contains the exact letters as the word malach(angel). By making a bracha on the food that we eat we not only elevate the food, but more importantly elevate our souls. Good Shabbos!
