

Mishmash Parent Child Learning - 2/1 Parshat Bo - Younger Learners

1. What did Hashem do to Pharaoh's heart and what does that mean?(10:1-2)
2. What are the last three makot (plagues) that Hashem brings to the Egyptians in this parsha?

BONUS: Can you list all 10 makot in order?

3. What is the name of the Hebrew month that Hashem tells Moshe will be the first month? What holiday do we celebrate in that month today?(12:2)
4. What did Moshe tell the people to take on the 10th day of the month? (12:3)
5. What were the people told to do on the 14th day of the month? (12:6-7)
6. How were the people supposed to cook the lamb? How were they told to eat it? (12:8-11).
7. Why did the people need to put the blood of the lamb on their doorposts? (12:13)
8. What are the Jewish people not allowed to eat on Pesach? (12:15)
9. What did Bnei Yisrael take with them when they left Egypt? (12:34-36)
10. How many people left Egypt? (12:37)
11. How many years did Bnei Yisrael spend in Egypt? (12:40)

12. Moshe repeats all of Hashem's instructions to the people at the end of this parsha. Besides eating matzah for seven days he tells the people that they must "tell your child" the story. (13:8) When do we do this each year?

13. Moshe tells the people that the words should be a "sign on your hand, and a reminder between your eyes" (13:9). How do we do this today?

BONUS: What tefilah do we all say every day to remember this story and leaving Egypt?
