## **RUTH - IN MEMORY**

I first met Ruth twenty years ago in the lobby of my building. My wife, Rose, and I were considering buying an apartment in the building, and I ranted to check the condition of the building with an existing tenant. In the

by, I met a graceful, friendly, and lovely woman, Ruth, who, immediateintroduced herself and invited me up to her apartment to chat. As she filled me in on the details concerning the building, we launched a friendship that would last for the remainder of her life. Our relationship began with an unselfish and trusting offer to help me, a total stranger to her at that time. I was struck by how unusual this was for a New Yorker. Having come to New York from the Midwest, I had already become accustomed to the certain edge of paranoia that characterizes most New Yorkers. Ruth reminded me

of the warm and open friendliness that one experiences in the Midwest, but, only rarely in New York City. Her openess was my first clue as to Ruth's unique personality, always open

and friendly to people of all backgrounds and ages.

Ruth was a frequent visitor in our home and watched our son Sam grow from infancy into a mature nineteen year old. She always took a special interest in Sam, tracking his progress through elementary school, high school, and his year in Israel. Curiously, she was able to relate to him as well as she related to her own contemporaries.

Although Ruth identified as a Jew, she was not very knowledgeable about her heritage nor did she seem to be very interested. Over the years, however, we shared many holiday and Shabbat meals together. I watched with amazement as

Ruth became involved in the Beginners Service, Lincoln Square Synagogue, NJOP, and various Jewish programs on the Upper West Side. I have always been somewhat startled at the transformation that took her from a completely secular Jew to a committed Jew who pursued learning at every opportunity. She would often speak of Rabbi Buchwald with a mixture of awe and love.

Over the years, Ruth developed an incredible attachment to Yiddishkeit. Nothing excited her more that preparing a D'var Torah for the Beginners Service. I remember when Ruth brought her proposed D'var Torah down to our apartment for scrutiny. She wanted to make certain that her thoughts

were appropriate and consistent with Torah values. She also needed to make certain that she would effectively share her joy at being able to address her comrades in the Beginners Service. The thought of the student becoming the teacher left her elated.

Each year, at Shavuot, it was my job to accompany Ruth to the allnight Beginners' learning so that I could walk her home afterward. Truthfully, I would often begin to nod off and wish that I were in bed. Yet, I stayed until the end because Ruth needed my assistance to get home.

When Ruth became seriously ill, I found myself even more impressed by her. Ruth's cheerful demeanor and grace in the face of a devastating illness was a continuous source of inspiration to Rose and myself. From her

sickbed, she was still connecting with people of all ages, and even found time to arrange for a contractor to help us out in our apartment. When Ruth found a music therapist from the hospice that particularly touched her, she organized a party in her bedroom for about 25 of her close friends.

During her illness, we had the opportunity to become very friendly with Gail, Ruth's daughter from Bar Harbor, Maine. We were able to witness a coming to terms between mother and daughter during a most difficult time. During this period, Gail became as much a part of our family as her mother. Although Gail approaches the world from a different perspective, she has impressed us with her deep spirituality and caring. Rose and I have felt privileged to know both Ruth and Ğail.

Much of the joy in Ruth's life over the past several years has come from her association with Rabbi Ephraim Buchwald. The special bond that the two of them shared led to a more fulfilled life for Ruth and I am quite sure that it enriched Rabbi Buchwald's life as well. I witnessed Rabbi Buchwald's nightly phone calls to Ruth's sick bed, his frequent visits to the hospital and to her home, and his sincere support of a good friend in

Ruth may not have been young in years when she began her journey into Yiddeshkeit, but she was young in spirit, and that spirit inspired us all. Her caring and love will be sorely missed by all of us.
