# JUDAISM, A WELL WRITTEN SONNET

Learning Jewish law can be a little intimidating for a beginner; it cerrainly seemed so to me. How was I going to learn the ins and outs of H. hah? Torah, Gemara, Pirkei Avot... so many things to study! But after taking a number of beginner classes, something that I had read came to mind: the concept of comparing a good life to a sonnet. In other words, a good life has form and structure, balance, an identifiable rhythm, just like a sonnet, and is filled with positive actions, which are like words of great beauty. And it occurred to me that that's what Jewish law is all about, a way to teach us how to turn our lives into sonnets.

My own spiritual journey -- learning Jewish law, learning how to daven, studying Torah -- seems very much like the experience of learning how to

write. Before anyone can write, they have to learn the basics. Each of us started out learning the alphabet. Then we learned how to put those letters together to form words and sentences. With each level in school, our vocabulary grew and our writing skills increased. And, slowly, after a few years, we were What had seemed able to write. overwhelming was now second nature. However, knowing how to write doesn't make you an exceptional writer. You can learn the rules and the structure, but in order to become more than just passable, you need to practice; and, to write a good sonnet, you have to practice a lot and be able to make it your own, to infuse it with your own spirit. I'm sure that Shakespeare wasn't writing brilliant sonnets when he first started; and I would also venture to guess that even

when he became a skilled writer, he continued to throw away a lot of

drafts before he produced his beautiful poetry.

Because I'm a beginner when it comes to Judaism, it's good for me to nber that even those people that are true artisans of their chosen pa... in life had to work hard to get there and were beginners once too. I find it interesting that when I'm learning Jewish law or learning the proper way to daven, I feel very much like I did when I was a child just starting school. It's exciting, frustrating, confusing, wonderful and mysterious all at the same time. But just like when I was small, I can look to those who are learned and who are, in a sense, older than I am because of their knowledge, and know that I can become proficient too. It's also inspiring to know that Rabbi Akiba didn't start studying until he was 40.

That means there's hope for all of us!

Much of Jewish law is very dense conceptually, and it's not easy to grasp what's being said the first or even the fifth time studying a particular law. But I believe the Torah and Talmud are patient teachers. Like any good teacher, they know we're going to make mistakes. We may misinterpret or even have no comprehension as to why a law exists when we first read it, but with much study and good teachers comes understanding and a structure on which to build our lives. The pieces start to fit together, and we can see the possibility of what good moral and ethical behavior is and what it can bring to our lives.

I suppose some people might view the law as restrictive. Why should

I keep kosher? Why shouldn't I use my car on Shabbat or carry things outside my home or use the phone? And yet, if people were writing any way they pleased, made up their own rules of grammar for example, or used their own symbols for punctuation, it would create chaos. People wouldn't be able to communicate. In the same way that written language needs structure and rules, we need structure and rules within ourselves and in our community so that is has shape and balance.

Certainly the law is not always easy to understand, but when we do start to grasp what it has to give us, it provides a permanent foundation and structure for our lives; and that is worth struggling for, working to make the proverbial light go on. By making Torah study a priority, we can start to choose the words, or actions,

we put in our life sonnets appropriately, avoiding the ones that are jarring or harmful, that break the rhythm of the "life lines" we are trying to create.

With great love, G-d gave the Jewish people the Torah, and we celebrate that incomparable gift during Shavuot. Yes, Torah asks a lot of people as individuals and as part of the Jewish community, and we have to study it and work to understand it in order to incorporate it into our lives. But if we make the effort to learn, it means each of us can live a richer, more fulfilling life, a Jewish life, a life blessed by G-d. It gives us the opportunity to turn our lives and our communities into something exquisite, balanced, and precious, just like a well-written sonnet.
