Eighteen years ago, deep in anxiety over whether the Ohio State Buckeyes would make it to the Rose Bowl and if our family's chain of clothing stores would make its holiday sales numbers, I crazily accepted an offer to meet a girl who lived three states away. This meant that on the Friday after Thanksgiving, traditionally the busiest retail day of the year, I'd be traveling from Ohio to spend Shabbat in New York City for the sole purpose of "dating." Over

my sense of duty as company president, not to mention the ire of my father and boss ("Why can't you find a girl from here?"), ultimately I made the lonely and unpopular decision to be crazy and to follow my gut.

The Shabbat with Sharon was a turning point in my life. The next turning point was, on Sharon's insistence, meeting one-onone with Effie Buchwald. Sharon explained that Rabbi Buchwald was her spiritual guide. She would need his ok to take our relationship to the next level.



The Meeting

Sharon set up the meeting--I was terrified. This famous NYC Rav was doubtlessly set on seeing one of his prize pupils hook up with a cool, rich, well-built Northeast-based

mud Chacham. Then I walk in, a hefty, corn-fed Midwesterner who can't read or write Hebrew, with no Yeshiva background, and not yet Shomer Shabbat. In Effie's office (which was the size of a large postage stamp), he proceeded to grill me, yet through it all he was kind, respectful and, to my eternal relief, did not make me feel

### The Report to Sharon

Two days later, Sharon called me in Columbus. My heart raced as I braced for rejection, and it continued to race even as I was informed that I had passed. With Effie's blessing we continued to date. We were engaged four weeks later.

Effie's Nod

Looking back, Effie's endorsement was perhaps the single biggest event of my life. That Hashem put this agent in the world--an angel of chesed who, 18 years ago, looked at who I was rather than at all the external trappings--shocked and astounded me. I was neither Shomer Shabbat, Kosher, nor very learned, but I had been exposed enough to recognize the validity of Yiddishkeit.

I knew I wanted to grow in that direction, and Effie believed in me. Eight months later he blessed us further by officiating at our wedding. At that time he called me a "natural Jew." No beard, no kippa, no gemmora, yet he called me a "natural." I cried under the chupah as words from Effie's heart entered our own.

Effie's nod has served for 18 years as a catalyst in my service to Hashem. That by Divine Providence my life was blessed with both him and Sharon, continues to inspire me to strive to live up to the obligations put

forth at Sinai.

Sharon and I have been blessed with four wonderful children--Rachael, Akiva, Aryeh, and Shalom. I regularly tell them the single greatest miracle of my life was meeting Mommy.

Today, if you asked me what I do for a living, I'd answer, as did Jonah, that I am a Jew and fear Hashem. I sport a beard, hat, and full time kippa confidently and with the utmost of pride. There is so much yet for the Goodman family to do, for all Jews to do. We must work together to make this world a dwelling place for Hashem and bring the much anticipated redemption. In my case, my life's journey and essential meaning began with Effie's nod.
