An Interview with Bob Novig

beginners of Lincoln Square Synagogue are a community within a munity, a self-styled family, if you will. Like every family, LSS Beginners have their newcomers and their old timers, their right wingers and their left wingers, and everyone in between. To capture the flavor of the community, Bereishith went one-on-one with long-time LSS Beginners' member Roberto (Bob) Novig:

BEREISHITH: As a fine, upstanding member of the LSS Beginners Service, we thought that we'd get your impressions of the Passover holiday. Any favorite aspects about Passover?

BOB: Well, I know that Passover is not one of the four official "New Years" on the Jewish calendar, but for me, it's a new year — it's my bachelor's New Year! You know, it forces me to spring clean my apartment. As for the Seder itself, I can say that my favorite parts are the beginning and the end, I can't wait till it starts, then I can't wait till its over.

<u>BEREISHITH:</u>Which of the four sons do you feel best describes you: wise, wicked, simple, or mute?

<u>BOB</u>: Well, perhaps you'd think I'd choose the wise one, but really, I relate to all of the above, having been described, at various times by other people, as one or all of the above. Thankfully, however, I can't relate to the fifth son, the one who never shows up at the Seder.

<u>BEREISHITH:</u> Do you have any strategies which help you get into the spirit of the Seder, to really feel as if you, yourself personally, were leaving Egyptian enslavement?

BOB: As I mentioned earlier, I see Passover as a new start, which is kind of like leaving the enslavement of the previous year. So I make it my m to finish off my Macallan's Single-Malt Scotch and then I set off to any some nice, crisp schmura matzah. Starting anew -- Free at last!

BEREISHITH: What plague inspires the most awe in you?

<u>BOB</u>: The 10th and final plague, the Death of the First Born. You see, in life, some people just don't get the message. With this plague, the Jews were finally out of there (Egypt)!! So really, it just shows you, never give up!

<u>BEREISHITH:</u> In case people are looking to invite you to the Seder in the near future, are you for fresh horseradish or the jar brand?

BOB: Fresh - really fresh! At Passover, as at all times, memories and experiences count, so the perfect horseradish can really affect the Passover experience. Sometimes you look at it and you think, no problem, it won't be so bad, and then *wham*, the right stuff that really knocks your socks off. Who wants that sappy mellow version.

<u>BEREISHITH:</u> What is the most creative *afikoman* hiding spot you have ever seen, and what was the most creative *afikoman* prize?

<u>BOB</u>: One time, the *afikoman* was hidden in a woman's pocketbook, and she left! Now that was a hiding spot. Of course, another favorite is to hide it in the chandelier.

As for the best prize? Well, for many, the *afikoman* prize is all about compromise, so I'd just say "The check is in the mail!"

<u>BEREISHUTH:</u> How has being part of the Lincoln Square community enhanced your appreciation of Passover?

BOB: Honestly, through LSS I have learned the true importance of g schmura matza, it's the perfect food to make you feel the impoverishment of enslavement -- \$15 a pound! Also, being part of the LSS community has given me the chance to participate in Rabbi Buchwald's Model Seder. All that entertainment really revs me up for the Seders.

<u>BOB:</u> What, I have a choice? Well, at the Seder I'll eat most everything, except tzimmis. During the week though, you can really get creative for the perfect Passover meal: matzah lasagna, matzah brie, Mexican matzah

BEREISHITH: Any favorite Passover dishes?

the perfect Passover meal: matzah lasagna, matzah brie, Mexican matzah omlette, or someone else's cooking.

<u>BEREISHITH:</u> Let's talk about the end of the Seder. You've recounted the exodus, you've sung praises to G-d, and now it's time to have some fun...what songs do you really get into?

<u>BOB</u>: I like all the songs...especially "Dayenu" and that one at the end, "Chad Gad'yah."

<u>BEREISHITH:</u> What is the best method you know for staying up, and in good spirits, for the whole Seder?

BOB: In all seriousness, I must say for the record that I like Passover and the best way to make Passover work for you is to be with the right group of people, family or friends. Also, it means a lot to be where the Seder is completed, 100%, just for the satisfaction of the experience. Year in and year out I love that feeling of accomplishment, of having done it all.

Passover, and the other holidays, are such great opportunities to grow and to live confidently with pride as Jews, as well as to strengthen our connection with the State of Israel.


<u>BEREISHITH:</u> Bob, they say that the process of finding the right mate (in your case a wife) is more difficult than the splitting of the Red Sea. What is your opinion on that?
