Sure, you can't explain Shavuot to your secular extended family, nor can you interest them in observing it. It's a diverse, tolerant crew (no rabbis allowed!), and the time before and after Yom Tov allows some take long hikes on the leafy trails in May sunshine, others to play softball (adults vs. kids) on a makeshift field, and still others to jog and bicycle with the young 'uns.

In this idyllic setting, we've cemented long-term friendships that have continued throughout the year, arranged joint vacations to the

West Coast, found medical treatment for long-time ailments, and taught our four-year-old how to read hiking trails.

This year, we're shifting venue, and four families are sharing a house on the beach in Delaware. We all look forward to davening together on Shavuot at a nearby synagogue and strolling on the beach in the moonlight. Of course, we also look forward to spending erev Yom Tov (the time before the holiday) splashing in the waves and throwing frisbees with the kids. Who knows what new tales and bonds of friendship will emerge?

Shavuot for us has become a way to observe Yom Tov in a communal, natural setting. And if anyone complains that the holiday reminds them of the disrespected Rodney Dangerfield, we counter that it exudes the sunny disposition of the Bill Cosby show.
