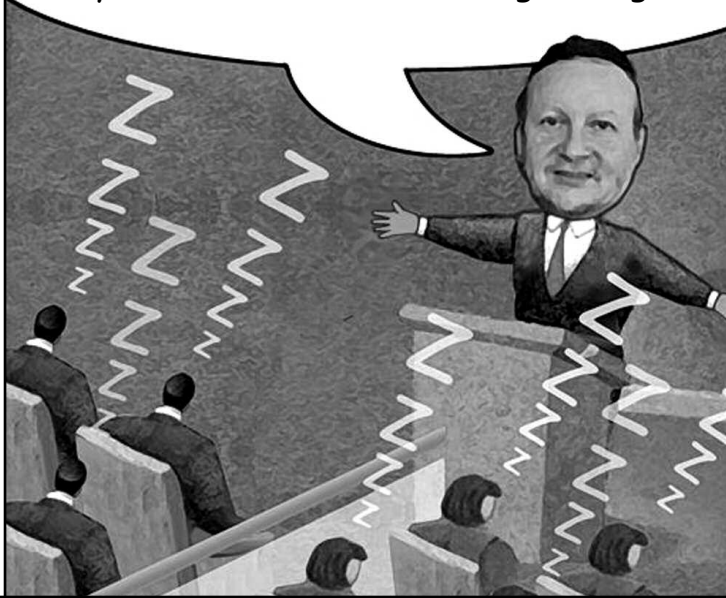


I don't mind them falling asleep, but they could have at least said good night!
