Parshat Nasso

Building a Mishkan

Parshat Nasso elaborates on the contributions that were required for the building of the mishkan.

The heads of each tribe make identical financial contributions. In accordance with their status and position, the princes' contributions are significantly larger than the half shekel anted up by each Israelite as reported in Parshat Bemidbar. The text's repetition underscores the importance of each tribe's contribution to the collective building fund for the mishkan. But the parsha opens by spotlighting highly individualistic roles in service to the mishkan. The descendants of Levi are assigned specific tasks, each of which is essential to the functioning of the whole. One role is unique to Aaron and his sons, another for Gershon's and still another for Merari's.
