### This Shabbat our children will learn...

Who is referred to as the 'second generation'? Who were the daughters of Zelophehad? How did they preserve their father's honor? When did G-d promise the land of Israel to Bnei Yisrael? What does Rav Papa's explain in Bava Basra 118?

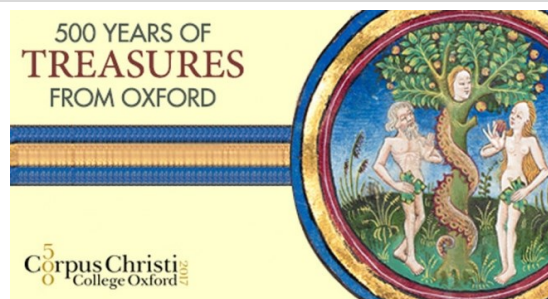
**Parsha in a Nutshell:** This week's Parsha, Pinchas, takes place approximately 40 years after the Exodus from Egypt as Bnei Yisrael prepare to enter Israel. This generation of Bnei Yisrael was the second generation, the children of those who had left Egypt. The daughters of Zelophehad preserve their father's honor by not announcing his sin. They exemplified Kibud Av V'Em through their protest to Moshe that their father was not part of Korach's rebellion and they too should be included in the allocation of land. Proof of their heritage was in Parshat Va'aira where G-d promises "I will bring you to the land.. And I will give it to you as a heritage."

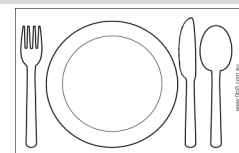
