**This Shabbat** Youth Groups will discuss the practical commandments of today, many of which are covered in the over 50 *Mitzvot* mentioned in this week's Parshat Re'eh. The Youth Department will cover a timeline of the *Mishkan* before the building of the *Beit Hamikdash*, the concept of *Tzedaka*, *Shechita*, *Kashrut*, and *Chok*, and where *Ma'aser* was exemplified by our forefathers Avraham, Yitzchak, and Yakov, even before the giving of the Torah.

Where were the locations of the *Mishkan* before the building of the first *Beit Hamikdash*? What is the one law of *Shmitta* outside of *Eretz Yisrael*?  
What is done with *Ma'aser Shaini*? Who is a *schochet* and what is a *chok*?
