**Shabbat Theme:**  
Jewish Leadership

Shabbat Shalom! Ariella & Mendel

This week in Parshat Shoftim, Youth Groups will discuss the special *Mitzvot* for Leaders of the Jewish Nation: the Judges, the *Kohanim* (Priests), the Prophets, and the King. We will describe the great Sanhedrin of 70 Judges, the highest court of law, and the smaller courts, the Batei Din. Batei Din had 23 members and are still used in judgements today. When we daven *Shemona Esrei* during the week, we pray "Please, Hashem, bring back our judges like before," to bring *Moshiach* and set up the Sanhedrin. The Parsha explains that the king was responsible for leading the military. Whoever had built a new house and hadn't dedicated it, grown a vineyard but had not eaten from it, gotten engaged to a woman but not married her, or was afraid, was told by the *Kohen Mashuach Milchama* (Priest Anointed for War) to return home.

### We will discuss:

How many judges made up the Sanhedrin? Why does Hashem command us to have judges and a king? What were the special restrictions of a king and what did he carry with him? How many witnesses are required for the court to make a conviction? What are the four categories that the Kohen said should return from battle? When did Rabbi Yehuda ben Bava risk giving *Semicha* to five of his students?

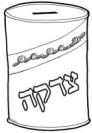
