## WECLOME NEW RABBINIC INTERN, ZAC SCHWARTZ

Zac Schwartz is excited to be joining LSS as our Rabbinic Intern. Originally from Sydney, Australia, Zac has been learning in Yeshivot Machon Meir, Yesodei Hatorah, Shapell's, Har Etzion (Gush) and the Rabbi Isaac Elchanan Theological Seminary for the last seven years. In Australia he received a bachelors in Commerce from the University of New South Wales. In Israel he completed the twoyear Shalhevet Rabbinic Leadership Course, the Machon L'Madrichei Chutz La'Aretz Informal Education training program and learnt for several years in Herzog College. In New York he was part of the first cohort to complete the joint RIETS/Ferkauf Certificate in Mental Health Counseling, and has also completed the Gottman Method Couples Therapy Certificate Level 1.



Zac has also been heavily involved in both formal and informal Jewish education for the last decade. He taught on the Judaic Studies Faculty in Moriah College, Sydney, Australia for four years and worked as a Rebbe in Yeshivot Makor Chayim and Shvut Yisrael in Israel. In the US he worked as a Rebbe at multiple summer in addition to being a Rabbinic Intern and Youth Director at Congregation Ohav Sholom in Merrick, Long Island for two years. He recently finished working as the Youth Director in Congregation Beth Abraham in Bergenfield, NJ, in charge of over one thousand children in the youth department. He has also served as the Scholar in Residence at the Congregation of Redbridge, London.

In this week's Parsha, Re'eh, the Torah continues Moshe's

famous last monologue. We learn again the laws and signs of Kashrut; a kosher mammal has split hooves and chews its cud and a kosher fish has fins and scales.

The Torah does not provide the signs of a kosher bird. Instead, the Torah lists treif

(non-kosher) birds, all of which are birds of prey. Our tradition is to eat the birds our ancestors ate.

On the topic of birds' kosher status, the Midrash says to look at the bird's companions; if the bird hangs out with kosher birds such as chickens and ducks, the bird is likely kosher. If this bird is amongst eagles, hawks, and birds of prey, this bird is assumably treif. Likewise, one way to judge a person is to look at their friends and companions. A person who has good friends will be influenced in a positive way; one who hangs out with with unhappy or less worthwhile friends can be led astray. For us, the key takeaway is to have good friends so that we can be good too.
