Extend the 10-Year Memorandum of Understanding

Today, Israel faces an unprecedented array of threats stemming from the growing instability in the Middle East. These challenges require Israel to significantly increase its defense expenditures. America must continue to help ensure that Israel has the resources to respond decisively to threats ranging from Hezbollah in the near term to a potentially nuclear-armed Iran in the longer term.

The current Memorandum of Understanding under which the United States provides security assistance to Israel expires in 2018, and discussions between the two allies are underway on the terms of a new agreement. There is a bipartisan resolution that expresses support for a swift conclusion to a new, expanded MOU. Please urge your representative to support this bipartisan measure.
