This Shabbat, Lincoln Square Synagogue welcomes our honored guest Naftali Moses, father of Mercaz Harav massacre victim Avraham David Moses

Following the gruesome homicidal spree by a lone Palestinian gunman at **Yeshivat Mercaz HaRav** in March 2008, **Naftali Moses** penned the inspirational memoir *Mourning Under Glass*, a description of his experiences dealing with the loss of his 16 year old son and his struggles with the frustrations of memory and memorial. A resident of Efrat and a professor of Jewish medical ethics, Naftali is regularly invited to speak to groups about living with loss caused by an act of terror. Dr Moses' trip has been sponsored and organized by One Family, Israel's only national organization solely dedicated to the rehabilitation of victims of terror attacks and their families.

### HILCHOT TISHA B'AV Prohibitions

- ◆ No eating, drinking, washing, anointing, wearing leather shoes, marital relations, or extending greetings.
- ◆ No learning Torah, except for sections dealing with the destruction of the Temple; i.e. The Book of Eicha and the account of the destruction in Tractate Gittin (56a-58a).
- ◆ No tallit and tefillin in the morning. We do, however, put them on at Mincha on Tisha B'Av afternoon.
- ◆ No sitting on chair of normal height until Chatzot (1:02pm on Tuesday).
