The New York Times has supported the Iran nuclear deal on its editorial page. Yet, earlier this week, they published a front page news analysis titled <u>Future Risks of Iran Deal</u>. The article painted a far less glossy view of the deal, including: "... most of the significant constraints on Tehran's program lapse after 15 years — and, after that, Iran is free to produce uranium on an industrial scale."
