Security Committee Alert - Aug 3, 2013

Exit Doors

For security purposes please exit the shul only through the <u>main entrance</u> and <u>never</u> through any other exit door. If you pass by an exit door always check to make sure it is locked. If not, slam it shut immediately and then inform security.
