The LSS Sukkah

We are aware that many of our Manhattan members have space restrictions that prevent them from having a personal sukkah. Therefore, we would like to invite all of our members and friends to utilize the LSS Sukkah during the Holiday in order to take part in mitzvah of dwelling in the Sukkah. In order to reserve a spot for eating any of the Yom Tov meals during the first days of Sukkot and Shabbat Chol Hamoed, a reservation must have been made in advance.

However, during the rest of Chol Hamoed and the last days of the Yom Tov, a reservation is not necessary to eat a meal in the Sukkah. Please feel free to use our Sukkah for eating, learning, relaxing, and general dwelling. We do not allow sleeping overnight in the LSS sukkah.

The entrance to the Sukkah is through the main entrance, up the stairs or elevator to the second floor, and straight down the hall on to the second floor terrace. We will only be allowing access in to the building and to the Sukkah from **6:30am until 10:00pm.**
