The High Holidays are quickly approaching. 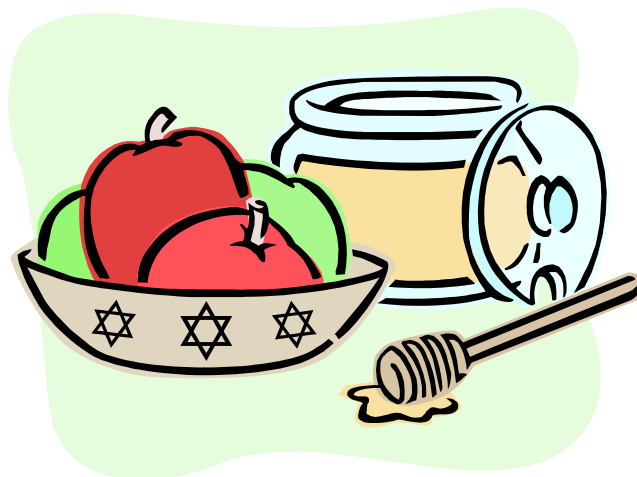
