♦ No tallit and tefillin in the morning. We do, however, put them on at Mincha on Tisha B'Av

A regular meal is easten Monday afternoon, which may not include wine meat or wine. Fowllowing benching, a special meal consisting of bread and a hard boiled egg with ashes is eaten while sitting on the floor. You do not have to take off your shoes for the meal. The meal must conclude before 8:09pm.


