Starting on October 20th, the Metropolitan Opera will stage eight presentations of the controversial opera, "The Death of Klinghoffer." The opera has been widely denounced as justifying the Palestinian terrorists who hijacked the Achille Lauro cruise ship in 1985, murdered disabled veteran Leon Klinghoffer only because he was Jewish, and dumped him and his wheelchair overboard. Klinghoffer's two daughters have joined the denunciations. If you believe that in a world filled with kidnappings, terrorism and atrocities Leon Klinghoffer's murderers should not be romanticized, we urge you to e-mail your feelings to Met general manager Peter Gelb at pgelb@metopera.org.
